Declaration of interest

There were no declarations

Confirmation of the minutes

The minutes of the **13 November 2025** meeting was accepted as a true record, proposed by Dylan Davies and seconded by Geraint Thomas.

Matters arising:**Fixing the wall at Arwelfa Cemetery**

It was reported that the work to the wall is almost complete.

SP Energy: It was decided to report the damage to a wall / culvert near to Park Hill to the County Council.

Public Footpaths: It was reported that NRW will put up signs and a kissing gate on footpath 49 as soon as the forestry work is complete.

Public Toilet: It was decided to obtain prices for installing an extractor fan.

School Bus: It was reported that children are still having to stand on the school bus due to a lack of available seats. It was decided to write to Janet Finch-Saunders.

Flooding - New Track, Carrog: It was reported that the problem persists. It was decided to contact the County Council's land drainage department.

The use of White Street as a Byway Open to All Traffic: It was reported that the Highways Department is looking into the matter and will report back.

Trwsio giât yr eglwys: Adroddwyd bod un dyfynbris wedi dod i law. Penderfynwyd gofyn am ddyfynbrisiau gan gontractwyr eraill i'w cymharu â chysylltu ag yswirwyr y cyngor.

Diffibrilwyr – Ardal Wybrnant, Glasgwm a Phen-y-Ffridd Llanerchigwynion: Adroddodd y Clerc fod y cyngor wedi cael cynnig diffibrilwyr yn rhad ac am ddim ac, oherwydd terfyn amser byr, ei fod wedi cyflwyno ceisiadau ar gyfer dau leoliad: un yn Nhŷ Coch, Wybrnant fel y trafodwyd yn y cyfarfod blaenorol ac un ar gyffordd Ffordd Ysbytty a Ffordd Groesffordd.

Penderfynwyd cefnogi gosod diffibriliwr ar Ffordd Ysbytty. Yn ystod y drafodaeth, awgrymwyd y gallai Glasgwm fod yn lleoliad mwy addas ar gyfer uned na'r safle a gynhigiwyd yn flaenorol yn Wybrnant.

Hyfforddiant diffibriliwr: Nodwyd diddordeb ymhlith trigolion Cwm Penmachno. Bydd y cyngor yn casglu adborth ar ddyddiau ac amseroedd addas i drefnu sesiwn.

Cwyn ynghylch cyflwr eiddo ac ymddangosiad stryd – White Street: Adroddwyd bod cwyn wedi dod i law ynghylch cyflwr un o'r tai yn White Street. Nodwyd pryderon ynghylch tri cherbyd, dau feic modur a nifer o eitemau a oedd wedi'u storio ar hyd ochr wal capel Bethania, gan wneud i'r stryd edrych yn flêr. Cytunwyd i gyfeirio'r mater at y Cyngor Sir.

Dympio gwastraff cartref yn anghyfreithlon: Derbyniwyd sawl adroddiad am ddympio gwastraff cartref, gan gynnwys clytiau, yn y goedwig rhwng Ffordd Glasgwm a Ffordd Tŷ Coch. Nodwyd bod y sbwriel yn cynnwys dogfennau a oedd yn adnabod teulu lleol. Mae'r mater wedi'i adrodd i Gyfoeth Naturiol Cymru a'r Heddlu.

Adroddiad Cyllidol

Darparodd y Clerc restr o'r holl drafodion ariannol ers y cyfarfod diwethaf i'w dadansoddi. Cytunwyd bod popeth mewn trefn.

HSBC – terfyn taliad dyddiol: Penderfynwyd cynyddu'r terfyn taliad dyddiol o £3,000 i £10,000

Trydan ar gyfer goleuadau Nadolig: Adroddwyd bod trigolyn lleol wedi talu costau trydan ar gyfer goleuadau Nadolig Penmachno, cyfanswm o £12 eleni. Er nad

Repairing the church gate: It was reported that one quote had been received. It was decided to ask for quotes from other contractors for comparison and to contact the council's insurers.

Defibrillators – Wybrnant, Glasgwm and Pen-y-Ffridd Llanerchigwynion: The Clerk reported that the council had been offered defibrillators free of charge and, due to a short application deadline, had submitted requests for two units: one at Tŷ Coch, Wybrnant as discussed at the previous meeting and one at the junction of Ysbytty Road and Groesffordd Road.

Members resolved to support the installation of a defibrillator on Ysbytty Road. During discussion, it was suggested that Glasgwm valley might be a more suitable location for a unit than the previously proposed site at Wybrnant.

Defibrillator training: Interest was noted among Cwm Penmachno residents. The council will gather feedback on suitable days and times to arrange a session.

Complaint regarding condition of property and appearance of street - White Street: It was reported that a complaint had been received regarding the condition of one of the houses in White Street. Concerns were noted regarding three vehicles, two motorbikes and a number of items stored along the wall of Bethania chapel, making the street appear untidy. It was agreed to refer the matter to the County Council.

Illegal dumping of household waste: Several reports had been received about the dumping of household waste, including nappies, in the forest between Glasgwm Road and Tŷ Coch Road. It was noted that the rubbish contained documents identifying a local family. The matter has been reported to NRW and the Police.

Financial Report

The Clerk provided a list of all financial transactions since the last meeting for analysis. It was agreed that everything was in order.

HSBC – daily payment limit: It was decided to increase the daily payment limit from £3,000 to £10,000

Electricity for Christmas lights: It was reported that a local resident had covered the electricity costs for the Penmachno Christmas lights, amounting to £12 for the season. Although no reimbursement had been
