RESOLVED: to confirm the minutes of the last meeting as an accurate record.

Adroddiad y Clerc:

Derbyniwyd a nodwyd adroddiad y Clerc ar faterion gweinyddol a gweithredol cyfredol.

Bwrdd Arddangos: Rhoddodd y Clerc y wybodaeth ddiweddaraf i'r Cyngor ar y cynnydd yn dilyn y penderfyniad ym mis Mai ynghylch bwrdd arddangos ar grŵn y pentref, Penmachno. Er mwyn symud ymlaen â'r cynnwys a'r dyluniad fel y cytunwyd yn flaenorol, **PENDERFYNWYD** ffurfio gweithgor yn cynnwys y Cyngorwyr Bethan Corrigan, Claire Roberts, Dylan Davies a Geraint Thomas. Bydd y Gweithgor yn adrodd yn ôl gyda'u hargymhellion, dyluniadau arfaethedig, a diweddariadau ariannu i'r Cyngor llawn mewn cyfarfod yn y dyfodol.

Clerk's Report:

The Clerk's report on ongoing administrative and operational matters was received and noted.

Information Board: The Clerk updated Council on progress following the May resolution regarding the Penmachno village green information board. To progress the content and design as previously agreed, it was **RESOLVED** to form a working group consisting of Cllrs Bethan Corrigan, Claire Roberts, Dylan Davies and Geraint Thomas. The Working Group will report back with their recommendations, proposed designs, and funding updates to the full Council at a future meeting.

Public Toilet: Authority was previously delegated to Cllr. Geraint Thomas to undertake the replacement of the extractor fan with a simple passive vent. Following a reminder, Geraint and Cllr. Wil Edwards are scheduled to carry out the work shortly, which involves creating an opening in the wall/roof structure to install the vent. Receipts for materials purchased for the works are to be submitted to the Clerk for reimbursement once the work is complete.

Tŷ Swch, Cwm Penmachno: Conwy Environmental Health advised that the issue falls outside their remit and should be directed to the National Park Authority (actioned by the Clerk). **RESOLVED:** Following reports that rubbish is currently being burned at the site, the Clerk to report the matter to Natural Resources Wales.

Financial Report

The Clerk presented a list of all financial transactions since the last meeting for review. **RESOLVED:** Council approved the transactions and agreed that all financial matters were in order.

Council discussed ongoing concerns regarding non-compliance with the 20mph speed limit, highlighting major issues with vehicles leaving the village in the direction of the A5 and on the road entering from Cwm Penmachno. A *speed table* was suggested as a potential option.

RESOLVED: To defer the item to allow time to consider options further.

Condition of public footpath 55 – y Waen

RESOLVED: To raise the condition of Public Footpath 55 (Y Waen) with Chris Roberts at the County Council during the upcoming site meeting.

Wastewater treatment works, Cwm Penmachno – to address the ongoing failure of the Cwm Penmachno works and determine the Council's next steps in challenging Dŵr Cymru's delayed 2028 action plan

Council expressed concern over the ongoing performance failures of the Cwm Penmachno wastewater treatment works and Dŵr Cymru's delayed 2028 action plan.

RESOLVED: The Clerk to contact Natural Resources Wales again to urge regulatory / enforcement action against Dŵr Cymru regarding the ongoing pollution issues, copying in a local Senedd Member (MS) to seek their political support.

The County Council's Environment, Roads and Facilities Department and the "Report It" system: to consider ways of raising public awareness of how to report issues directly to Conwy, and to decide on the course of action

Council discussed the County Council's Environment, Roads, and Facilities Department and the "Report It" online system. It was emphasised that the public should report issues directly to Conwy CBC - rather than routing them through the Community Council. The service offers huge advantages and leads to much quicker resolutions.

RESOLVED: To publish a post on the Community Council's Facebook page to raise public awareness of the

RESOLVED: The Clerk to invite a representative from BT to attend the upcoming Community Fun Day to answer residents' questions and offer advice, or alternatively request leaflets to distribute to the public.

Frequency of council meetings – to consider a request from Cllr. Wil Edwards to change the frequency of Council meetings from every two months to monthly

Council considered a proposal from Cllr. Wil Edwards (seconded by Cllr. Dafydd Gwyndaf) to increase the frequency of Council meetings from once every two months to monthly.

- A detailed discussion took place regarding the substantial administrative impact on the Clerk, noting that preparing additional statutory summonses, agendas, website updates, and minutes would divert significant time away from delivering practical community projects and resolving local issues.
- It was noted that if urgent decisions are required between scheduled meetings, the Chair retains the statutory power to convene an Extraordinary Meeting at any time with the required three clear days' notice, with options to meet virtually if necessary.

RESOLVED: The motion to move to monthly meetings was defeated following a vote (2 in favour, 6 against). Council meetings will remain on a schedule of once every two months.

Location of council meetings – to consider holding Community Council meetings in Cwm Penmachno as well as Penmachno, and to decide on suitable arrangements including multi-location accessibility

Council considered a proposal to hold Community Council meetings in Cwm Penmachno in addition to Penmachno.

RESOLVED: To hold two Council meetings per year in Cwm Penmachno, with the specific dates and venues to be determined by agreement of the Council on a flexible basis.

Noted: The Council received and noted various correspondence and updates for information purposes, including:

Correspondence: A query regarding dog rules on open access land, an update on the Cwm mobile mast upgrade, burial inquiries, and Openreach's broadband fibre rollout plans.

Footpaths & Highways: Confirmation that footpaths 58 and 55 have been cleared by Gari Morris, alongside reports regarding overgrown roadside trees and vegetation (being monitored/handled by Cllr. Dilwyn Roberts).

General Updates: Updates regarding SP Energy works, potential unauthorised building works at a property in Cwm, progress on removing an abandoned trailer, and a request for an update from the Penmachno charity.

Items for Inclusion on the Agenda of the Next Meeting

Noted: Cllr. Dafydd Gwyndaf requested that an item be included on the next agenda regarding potential additional parking in Cwm Penmachno (specifically utilising the field adjacent to the park alongside the terraced houses). The Clerk was instructed to ascertain land ownership for this plot prior to the next meeting so that full information is available for Council discussion.

Cllr. Dafydd Gwyndaf raised concerns regarding a blocked drain at Blaen Cwm, Cwm Penmachno. The Clerk will place the item on the agenda for further discussion and to inspect or contact the relevant authority to determine responsibility and clear the drain.
